

Universities and colleges tuition fees can vary. If you start university in 2013, all your tuition fees will be covered by a tuition fee loan repayable after you graduate, and once you are earning above £21,000

For entry in 2013, the maximum tuition fee is £9,000.

- A repayable loan for living costs (max £5,500 outside London)
- A non-repayable Maintenance Grant (max £3,354)
- National Scholarship Programme
