Business of the UKC

HELOA

The UKC have met 4 times this year, twice online and twice in person with agenda items and votes including AGM 2024, group roles, election of trustees. In addition, the executive committee meet monthly to ensure awareness of projects, and goals across UKC and have discussed items such as primary contact reviews, carbon accounting, financial responsibility and procedures and communication and content. Decisions taken by Trustees and key items of note are communicated back to membership via Group meetings, and through the HELOA communication channels. Members are encouraged to raise items or feedback via Groups.

Key developments this year

- Fulfilling our previous strategy and developing the 2024-2026 strategy with focuses on EDI and sustainability.
- Completing our EDI consultation with EMBED and beginning the implementation of recommendations from the reports.
- Delivered over 40 local and national meetings, training events and engagements with over 45% of our membership.

External representation

We consult with several external organisations to promote informed choices and as Chair, I sit on the UCAS Council and can represent HELOA's views. I have attended 4 meetings this year conversing on topics like reform, strategy and upcoming changes and developments to the platform and how this affects the students and advisers we support.
